Staffing to support key interventions for literacy, numeracy and wellbeing. Interventions throughout the key stages and early years will be reviewed and strengthened. Staff to receive specialist training, in particular, for early support of fundamental literacy skills. This will impact on pupil standards and boost support for high-quality literacy interventions.2. Support assistants to develop bespoke interventions for FSM pupils3.
