Dear Parents/ Carers,

Home Learning Update

As a school, we are very mindful of the varying circumstances of all of our families. The current situation is very complex but we are doing our very best to provide a varied, flexible and multi-faceted home learning offer that will suit all of our community. During extended periods of lockdown, we have always placed a high level of importance on children being able to continue to connect with their teachers. Seeing their faces and hearing their voices is in itself motivation for the children to complete the tasks that have been set.

We have continued to review and extend learning opportunities for pupils. Once again, we cannot stress enough that whatever you can manage we very much appreciate.

Work packs

In previous lockdowns, we have also distributed a pack to all pupils. We are currently in the process of compiling further 'hard copy' materials to pupils.

We are hopeful that these will provide families with further flexibility. They should be with you in the next week. If you do not need a pack please let the class teacher know via Seesaw. Much of the work in these packs can be completed independently and will enable children to have a breather from screen time.

Live Streaming sessions	Year 3,4,5 & 6 twice a week. Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 once a week. Platform: Microsoft TEAMS (N-Y6)	Year 3,4,5 & 6 twice a week. Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 once a week.	These allow pupils to connect with their classmates and their teacher. The content primarily will focus on wellbeing. Teachers will provide encouragement and support. Live streaming sessions help to increase motivation. As these develop they will be used to alleviate misconceptions in learning or to model ways forward etc.

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Tips/expectations for parents when using live streaming

- ✓ Ensure children are ready for each session. If you have them, the wearing of headphones should be encouraged

- ✓ Respect the privacy and confidentiality of all pupils and staff in the sessions.
- ✓ Ensure that any devices being used by learners are not used inappropriately at any time
- ✓ Not to record or share any images or sound from the sessions taking place
